



Essential Turbines Inc. (ETI) represents and warrants that its workmanship conforms to the intent of the requirements of the manufacturer, and that its quality is in accordance with the applicable provisions of Transport Canada and multiple aviation administration regulations.

Engines, modules and accessories overhauled and/or repaired by ETI are warranted to be free of defects in workmanship performed by ETI for the remaining manufacturer's recommended time between overhaul or recommended calendar life, not to exceed 500 hours or twelve (12) months from shipment date.

RR M250 engines and modules overhauled by ETI are warranted to be free from material defects on the following basis:

- Zero (0) to five hundred (500) hours of operation 100%
- All workmanship warranties on the overhauled/repared engines, modules and engine components expire after 500 hours of operation or twelve (12) months since shipping date, whichever shall first occur.
- Accessories repair 500 hours from installation or twelve (12) months since shipping date, whichever shall first occur.

ETI's liability is limited to the time continued repair or replacement at its facilities and its option of the defective parts or accessories overhauled or repaired by ETI which are determined by ETI to have been defective due to faulty workmanship by ETI. Warranty allowances shall not exceed the net price shown on the original overhaul/repair invoice.

The responsibility of ETI under this warranty is further limited by the following conditions:

1. Defects in workmanship must be discovered before the manufacturer's recommended time between overhaul or calendar life has elapsed, and ETI must be given prompt notice in writing.
2. The engine and components must have been installed, preserved, maintained and operated in accordance with the manufacturer's directives and instructions; the engine and components must not have been altered or repaired outside of ETI's facilities; and the engine and components must not have been subject to misuse, neglect, accident or damage from the elements.
3. The engine or accessory component parts must be returned to ETI's facilities after notice or failure have been given, and ETI must be afforded the opportunity to perform corrective work at the facility of its choice (unless such work is otherwise authorized in writing by ETI).

ETI does not warrant parts, material, or services supplied or performed by companies other than Rolls-Royce M250 (as noted above) but agrees to use its best effort to ensure that the suppliers' and subcontractors' warranties with respect to such parts, materials and services will be extended to cover and be enforceable by the Customer. ETI will act for its Customers in the processing of any claims or adjustments arising out of and because of defective parts, materials and workmanship in accordance with such suppliers' and subcontractors' warranties.

This warranty is extended to the Customer at the time of delivery and may not be assigned without ETI's prior written consent.

Engine, module, or parts for which a warranty claim has been allowed, shall be returned to the Customer at ETI's expense. In the event that a warranty claim is denied, the engine, module or part shall be returned to the customer C.O.D and the cost of disassembly and reassembly to disclose the claimed defect and the cost of preparation of any technical report shall be borne by the customer at ETI's current applicable hourly rates.

Except as otherwise set forth herein, it is expressly agreed and understood that there are no other warranties express, implied or statutory, including warranties of merchantability or fitness, nor are there any affirmations of fact, guarantees, representations, commitments or promises by ETI with reference to the workmanship performed and materials provided by ETI.

In no event shall ETI be liable, whether in contract, tort or otherwise for special, consequential, incidental or indirect damages arising out of the workmanship performed or material supplied by ETI in the overhaul and/or repair of Customer's property, including but not limited to loss of revenues, loss of use of Customer's property or of any equipment to which Customer's property may be installed or for loss of use or damages due to late delivery. No agreement or understanding, varying or extending the terms of this warranty shall be binding upon ETI unless reduced to writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of ETI.
